

Tenant's Fees - July 2025

Should you have any questions in relation to the below then please contact us and we will provide you with all of the information that you may require.

Assured Shorthold Tenancies (AST) - the majority of tenancies.

Holding Deposit:	Equivalent to one week's rent (held for maximum of 14 days).
Rent In Advance:	Rent is paid in advance – equivalent to one month's rent.
Tenancy Deposit:	If rent is less than £50,000 per annum – equivalent to 5 weeks rent. If rent is more than £50,000 per annum - equivalent to 6 weeks rent.
Tenancy Swap:	£50 (inclusive of VAT).
Variation to Tenancy:	£50 (inclusive of VAT) if at the tenant's request & the landlord is agreeable.
Early Termination Costs:	Equivalent to the all the Landlord's costs, including all fees, to place a new tenant in the property.
During the tenancy:	Lost Keys/Fobs/Other Security Devices: Cost of replacement for all parties.
	Late Rent: If after 14 days, 3% chargeable over the BoE Base Rate.



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Non- Assured Shorthold Tenancy/Common Law Tenancies.

Holding Deposit: Equivalent to two week's rent. Rent In Advance: Rent is paid in advance – equivalent to one month's rent. Tenancy Deposit: Equivalent to 6 weeks rent. Tenancy Agreement Fee: £240 (inclusive of VAT). Reference Fee per Tenant: £48 (inclusive of VAT). £24 (inclusive of VAT). Right to Rent Check: Tenancy Swap: Will require a new Tenancy Agreement – as Tenancy Agreement Fee. Variation to Tenancy: Will require a new Tenancy Agreement – as Tenancy Agreement Fee.. Early Termination Costs: Equivalent to the all the Landlord's costs, including all fees, to place a new tenant. **During the tenancy:** Lost Keys/Fobs/Other Security Devices: Cost of replacement for all parties. Late Rent: (i) If after 14 days, 3% chargeable over the BoE Base Rate;

(ii) Charge of £24 (inclusive of VAT.
